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

LETTERS PATENT

WHEREAS an application has been filed to incorporate a corporation under the name

HELICOPTER ASSOCIATION OF CANADA

THEREFORE the Minister of Industry, Science and Technology by virtue of the powers vested in him by the Canada Corporations Act, constitutes the applicants and such persons as may hereafter become members in the corporation hereby created, a body corporate and politic in accordance with the provisions of the said Act. A copy of the said application is attached hereto and forms part hereof.

I

The undersigned hereby apply to the Minister of Consumer and Corporate Affairs for the grant of a charter by letters patent under the provisions of Part II of the Canada Corporations Act constituting the undersigned, and such others as may become members of the Corporation thereby created, a body corporate and politic under the name of

HELICOPTER ASSOCIATION OF CANADA

The undersigned have satisfied themselves and are assured that the proposed name under which incorporation is sought is not the same or similar to the name under which any other company, society, association or firm, in existence is carrying on business in Canada or is incorporated under the laws of Canada or any province thereof or so nearly resembles the same as to be calculated to deceive

II

The applicants are individuals of the full age of eighteen years with power under law to contract. The name, address and the occupation of each of the applicants are as follows:

The said BARRY JOHN HEWKO, GORDON KENNETH NORIE and CHARLES DOUGLAS MOONEY will be the first directors of the Corporation.

The objects of the Corporation are:

- 1. To ensure the financial viability of the Canadian Civil Helicopter Industry.
- 2. To educate members, civil servants, and the general public about issues important to the Industry.
- 3. To promote the continued enhancement of flight safety.
- 4. To develop expanded utilization of helicopter transport at all levels of Canadian life.
- 5. To exchange maintenance practices and common issues among members.

IV

The operations of the Corporation may be carried on throughout Canada and elsewhere.

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The place within Canada where the head office of the corporation is to be situated is:

Municipality of the Township of Langley British Columbia

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It is specially provided that in the event of dissolution or winding-up of the corporation, all its remaining assets after payment of its liabilities shall be distributed to one or more organizations in Canada carrying on similar activities. In accordance with Section 65 of the Canadian Corporations Act, it is provided that, when authorized by by-law, duly passed by the directors and sanctioned by at least two-thirds of the votes cast at a special general meeting of the members duly called for considering the by-law, the directors of the corporation may from time to time

- a) borrow money upon the credit of the corporation;
- b) limit or increase the amount to be borrowed;
- c) issue debentures or other securities of the corporation;
- d) pledge of sell such debentures or other securities for such sums and at such prices as may be deemed expedient; and,
- e) secure any such debentures, or other securities, or any other present or future borrowing or liability of the corporation, by mortgage, hypothec, charge or pledge of all or any currently owned or subsequently acquired real and personal, movable and immovable, property of the Corporation, and the undertaking and rights of the corporation.

Any such by-law may provide for the delegation of such powers by the directors to such officers or directors of the corporation to such extent and in such manner as may be set out in the by-law.

Nothing herein limits or restricts the borrowing of money by the corporation, on bills of exchange or promissory notes made, drawn, accepted or endorsed by or on behalf of the corporation.

VIII

The by-laws of the corporation shall be those filed with the application for letters patent until repeated, amended, altered or added to.

The corporation is to carry on its operations without pecuniary gain to its members and any profits or other accretions to the corporation are to be used in promoting its objects.
