

CAMC Wage Subsidy Program Accepting New Participants

CAMC is pleased to announce that the **2010 Career Focus** wage-subsidy program is again **accepting new participants!**

Due to overwhelming demand, the program enrollments available in spring 2010 were filled immediately. CAMC has now secured wage-subsidy funding for **another 20 enrollments** and is again accepting applications.

Wage-subsidy funding is available for employers in the aviation and aerospace industry to hire post-secondary graduates. **There are only 20 spaces available! Call soon and submit information about your new hire for a program eligibility review.**

Eligible Participants

- Must be a post-secondary graduate: Pilot, AMT, etc.
- Must be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, or a person who has been granted refugee status in Canada
- Must be legally entitled to work in Canada
- May not receive employment insurance benefits while participating in the program.
- Must be between 15 and 30 years of age

Eligible Employers

- Must inform potential participants of what participation in the program would entail, and retain agreement from participants (agreements are provided by CAMC)
- Must provide participants with full-time work for at least four (4) months
- Must provide wage/payroll data to CAMC as required (once per month).

Note: This additional round of wage subsidy funding will apply for wages paid until March 31, 2011, as opposed payments for wages to over a 12-month period.
